



"A Search for Knowledge and Freedom: The Polish-Canadian Perspective" (ISBN 9780969560340) is a 1994 publication documenting the proceedings of a 50th-anniversary of the Polish Institute of Arts and Sciences in Canada symposium held on November 20, 1993, which explored the cultural, intellectual, and political contributions of Polish immigrants in Canada.
